

Key conclusions from the Fourth Assessment Report of the Intergovernmental Panel



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We're in the midst of global warming - (0.8 +C warming so far; warmer than last 1300 years)

Anthropogenic greenhouse gas emissions are its main cause

Warming has increased the risk of extreme events - heat waves, droughts, flooding, intensity of tropical storms

Climate change will completely change the world if unchecked - 2-7 +C global warming by 2100, risk of "surprises"

Sea level rise:

- 20th Century: 15-20 cm
- Current rate: 3 cm per decade
- Until 2100: probably < 1 m</p>
- Centuries: several meters likely
- Regional variation due to ocean circulation
